The Good News

Over the past 32 years, Casa Bernabé has sought to be a model in residential care, providing comprehensive services to Guatemalan children that have been orphaned, abused, neglected and are at risk. They have sought to set a high standard of care for their children meeting their emotional, physical, academic, social and cognitive needs.

Since 2002, Friends of Children Everywhere has been committed to the support and care of the children at Casa Bernabé. Annually, we are responsible for raising 80% of their necessary funding.

Together, we are providing hope and healing through Jesus for vulnerable children in Guatemala, both within the walls of its campus and also within the surrounding community.

Lives are being transformed as the ties of generational poverty and abuse are broken through family modeling and education.

Children's Home

The children at Casa Bernabé live within nine different family units, where they are cared for by a loving Christian couple and are able to experience, often for the very first time, what it means to live in a family. Casa Bernabé provides each of these children with food, shelter, medical care, education, vocational training, and above all Christ-centered holistic care.

Transitional Living Program

Our Transitional Living Program helps young adults over age 18 learn to work, attend school, and acquire life skills in preparation for launching into Guatemalan society. Coupled with vocational training, the Transition Program accompanies the young adults of CB on their journey towards independence. Our youth gain the practical tools needed to break the cycle of poverty and integrate into society as responsible, contributing citizens.

Integrated Formation Program

This program offers vocational and workplace preparation with hands on education in areas such as welding, carpentry, computer programming, sewing, aesthetics and cooking. With an emphasis on education and life skills, we actively invest in the future of each of these young adults, giving them the opportunity to succeed in the path they choose once outside the care of Casa Bernabé.

Families United

This is a pioneer ministry committed to reconciling and restoring broken families. Casa Bernabé's team of dedicated professionals are committed to working alongside each of the families of our children and the Guatemalan government, conducting extensive visits, evaluations, & interviews, then preparing a plan that would unify the disintegrated home. The team provides follow-up and supervision once re-united

Medical Clinic

The Clinic began a partnership with the San Carlos University of Guatemala with the purpose of opening our clinic up to the surrounding community, as well as treating the children and staff at Casa Bernabé. This also program also provides the training for our young women to become a certified dental assistant. The clinic houses three psychologists, a pharmacy, and the dental clinic with a full time dentist.

Christian School

Offering Pre-K through 9th grade education, Casa Bernabé Christian School provides quality, Christ centered education. For more than 10 years, the school has also generously opened its doors to families in the surrounding community. Due to many economic and social limitations, in most cases, the children from these families would not have the chance to receive any kind of formal education.
